

Terms and Conditions – Billy the Blackbird Summer Fun Trail 2026 Prize Draw

Wigan Borough Council of Town Hall, Library Street, Wigan WN1 1YN ("the Council") is operating the Billy the Blackbird Summer Fun Trail 2026 prize draw subject to the following rules.

1. An entrant will be entered into the prize draw by completing the Council's Billy the Blackbird Summer Fun Trail 2026 map and providing their name, phone number and email address confirming they wish to be entered into the prize draw. Participants are deemed to have accepted and agreed to be bound by these terms and conditions. The Council reserves the right to refuse entry or refuse to award the prize to anyone in breach of these terms and conditions.
2. The prize draw is open to anyone aged 18 and over (except individuals directly associated with administration of the prize draw).
3. In entering the prize draw, you confirm that you are eligible to do so and eligible to claim any prize you may win. The Council may require you to provide proof that you are eligible to enter the prize draw.
4. To enter the prize draw, entrants must complete the Council's Billy the Blackbird Summer Fun Trail 2026 map between 19 July 2026 – 31 August 2026 and return their completed map to the Visitor's Desk at Pennington Flash. There is no other route of entry.
5. Only one entry will be permitted per person. Any person found to have multiple entries will be disqualified and considered ineligible.
6. There will be three winners. Each winner will receive a Billy the Blackbird bundle including Billy and the Birdfeeder book, pair of children's binoculars and colouring book. There is no alternative prize. The prize is non-exchangeable, non-transferable and no cash alternative is offered. The Council reserves the right to replace the prize with an alternative prize of equal value if circumstances beyond the Council's control makes it necessary to do so.
7. All completed Billy the Blackbird Summer Fun Trail 2026 maps received before the closing date (31 August 2026) will be entered into the prize draw, where the entrant has provided their name, phone number and email address confirming they wish to be entered into the prize draw.
8. The 3 winners will be selected at random.
9. The identity of these winners will be ascertained by the Council using their phone number and/or email address.
10. The winners will be notified by the Council by phone call or email within 14 days of the prize draw taking place.

11. If a winner does not confirm acceptance of the prize within 30 days, or if it is found that a winner is ineligible, then the winner will be considered to have forfeited the prize and the Council will be entitled to select another winner at random in accordance with these terms and conditions. If further alternate winner(s) are found to be ineligible, or do not confirm acceptance of the prize within the 30 day period, this process will be repeated in the same way until all eligible winners out of the prize draw entries are identified. Failing this no prize will be awarded.
12. Winners must collect their prize from the Visitor's Desk at Pennington Flash.
13. The Council must either publish or make available information that indicates that a valid award took place. To comply with this obligation the name of the winners will be available upon request in writing from the Council 60 days after the prize draw is completed. If you object to your name being made available, please contact the Council at iapf@leighsportsvillage.co.uk. In such circumstances, the Council must still provide the information and winning entry to the Advertising Standards Authority on request.
14. The Council will not be liable in any way if an entrant enters the prize draw unlawfully or in breach of these terms and conditions and such entrants will be considered to be ineligible.
15. The Council reserves the right to hold void, cancel, suspend, or amend the prize draw where it becomes necessary to do so.
16. The decision of the Council regarding any aspect of the prize draw is final and binding.
17. The Council cannot accept any responsibility whatsoever for any problem which may result in any entry being lost or not properly registered or recorded.
